Calling All Self-Advocates What is Self-Advocacy?

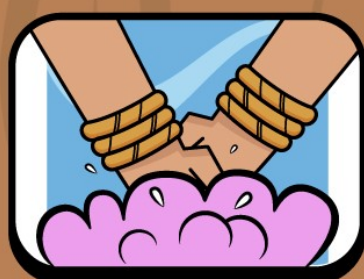

Why is Self-Advocacy important? So that you have, the knowledge and information needed to succeed and are given the chance to participate in making decisions that will improve your quality of life.

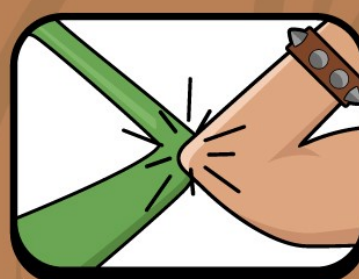
