LOOKING FOR HOMESHARE PROVIDERS



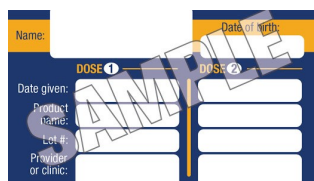
We are looking to recruit new home share providers! Pathways' home sharing program allows people in the community to share their home with an individual with diverse-abilities. This allows individuals to live in a safe and secure environment where they can learn skills to be more independent and receive support when needed.

Home Share Providers can be individuals, couples or families, and can live in owned or

rented premises. Home share providers must be approved based on the standards set by Community Living BC (CLBC). This includes completing an application, reference letters, home study, medical disclosure and a satisfactory criminal record search.
