CONSTRUCTION IS ALMOST COMPLETE!

Construction continues to be underway for our new affordable 68 unit apartment complex!

The rental building will provide homes for people with limited incomes and units for families, singles, seniors and people living with diverseabilities.





The six-storey wood frame building, in the heart of downtown, will feature parking and a mix of unit types from studios to two-bedrooms.

The building is called Hadgraft Wilson Place in recognition of two families who are

advocates for those with diverse-abilities and who have provided considerable support to Pathways.
