POLICY

There are two classes of membership:

Active: Any person who believes in the Mission and Mandate statements and is interested in supporting the activities of the Society may apply to the Board of Directors for active membership in the Society and upon acceptance of the application by the Board of Directors such person shall become an active member of the Society.

Associate: An employee of the Society and an employee or a representative of the Certified Bargaining Agent of the employees of the Society shall not be eligible to become active members of the Society. Such persons may apply to the Board of Directors for associate membership in the Society and upon acceptance of the application by the Board of Directors any such person shall become an associate member of the Society. An "employee" shall include all persons who receive a wage or salary from the Society, unless they are person with a diverse-ability. Associate members shall not be eligible to vote at meetings of the Society.

A member shall be in good standing except as outlined in Bylaw 2.5 and 9 of the Pathways Abilities Society Bylaws.
